As the District has been deemed an “essential” business during this crisis, this notice provides an update on our services and measures that the District has taken to limit the spread of Coronavirus (COVID-19).

We have instituted measures to protect the health and wellbeing of our staff and to ensure we are able to continue operating the District to meet your water demands. Some of the measures we have taken are outlined below, but we will continue answering your phone calls, make timely deliveries of irrigation water, and maintain the District:

- Operations staff continues to be onsite on our normal day and night schedule. All water orders must be done by phone, email, or fax (see the bottom of this page for contact information).
- We are requesting all payments be done by mail.
- Appropriate operation and maintenance staff will continue to work except those that feel the need to take sick or annual leave. We have also discussed “work from home” options for employees on a case-by-case basis.
- The office has been closed to the general public until further notice. Please call for an appointment if you need to come in for any business. We are evaluating options for the upcoming Board Meeting, but plan to have teleconference and web-based capability.
- All employees have been asked to maintain proper distancing and we will need the same from you and your employees in the field.

Your interests and the health of our employees as well as the public is at the forefront of our decision-making process. We will continue to review updates provided by official governmental agencies, implement best practices, and devote resources to ensure we are acting in the best interest of our staff and District landowners/water users.
